





• Charge the supplied battery pack before using the camera for the first time. • The camera is a precision instrument. Be careful not to bump the lens or the LCD screen, and not to


apply force to it. Attach the strap to prevent the camera from damage by being dropped, etc.



Charge the battery pack


Be sure to turn off your camera before charging starts.

Charging indicator




Light on: Charging **Light off:** Completed (Disconnect the AC Adaptor.)

Using the AC Adaptor

Use the camera connected to a wall outlet (wall socket) as illustrated above.

- Connect the AC Adaptor to an easily accessible wall outlet (wall socket). If any trouble occurs, immediately disconnect the plug from the wall outlet (wall socket).
- After use, disconnect the AC Adaptor both from the camera and from the wall outlet (wall socket).
- This set is not disconnected from the AC power source (mains) as long as it is connected to the wall outlet (wall socket) even if the set itself has been turned off.



• If you selected [D/M/Y] in step **3**-1, set the time on a 24-hour cycle.

• Midnight is indicated as 12:00 AM, and noon as 12:00 PM.

• If the camera is running on battery power and you do not operate the camera for a period of time, the camera turns off automatically to prevent wearing down the battery (Auto power-off function)

• Do not touch the lens portion as the cover opens and the lens portion extends. Also, do not leave the camera

with the lens portion extended for a long period of time with the power off as this may cause malfunction

Select [Clock Set] in the **=** (Setup) screen and perform the procedure in step **3** above.

• Unless you set the clock, the Clock Set screen appears each time the camera is turned on.

• The following screen appears when the camera is turned on for the second time or afterwards.

Changing the language setting

You can change the screen display to show messages in a specified language. To change the language setting, press MENU to display the menu screen. Select 🖶 (Setup) with the control button, then, select [A Language] in \blacksquare (Setup1), and select the desired language. \rightarrow "User's Guide/Troubleshooting" (page 50)





Open the cover, then push the "Memory Stick" in once. • If the access lamp is lit, never remove the "Memory Stick" or turn off the power. The data may be corrupted.

To delete images

- 1 Display the image you want to delete and press ## / m (delete).
- 2 Select [Delete] with ▲, then press ●.





To cancel the deletion Select [Exit], then press .

Checking the last still image you shot (Quick Review)

Press \blacktriangleleft (\bigcirc) on the control button.

To cancel, press ◀ again.

- The image may appear rough right after playback starts.
- To delete the image, press \blacksquare / $\stackrel{\bullet}{\blacksquare}$ (Delete) and select [Delete] with \blacktriangle on the control button, then press \blacksquare .

5 Selecting a flash mode for still images

Before step ②, press \blacktriangle (\diamondsuit) on the control button repeatedly until the desired mode is selected.

No indicator Strobes if it is dark or against light (default setting) Slow synchro (Forced flash) \$SL The shutter speed is slow in a dark place to clearly shoot the background that is out of flash light.

- Shooting distance (when [ISO] is set to [Auto])
- W side: Approx. 0.2 to 3.5 m (7 7/8 to 11 feet 5 3/4 inches)
- T side: Approx. 0.3 to 2.5 m (11 7/8 to 8 feet 2 3/8 inches)
- The flash strobes twice. The first time is to adjust the light quantity

Shooting close-up (Macro)

No flash

Before step ②, press \triangleright (③) on the control button.

To cancel, press ▶ again.

- Setting the zoom all the way to the W side is recommended.
- The in-focus range becomes narrow, and the complete subject may not entirely be in focus.
- The AF speed drops.

Shortest shooting distance from the lens surface

Setting all the way to the W side: Approx. 6 cm (2 3/8 inches)

Setting all the way to the T side: Approx. 30 cm (11 7/8 inches)

SUsing the self-timer

Before step ②, press \blacktriangledown (\diamondsuit) on the control button.

Press the shutter button, the self-timer lamp flashes, and a beep sounds until the shutter operates (approximately 10 seconds later).



If you shoot a still image of a subject that is difficult to focus on

- If the subject is closer than approx. 50 cm (19 3/4 inches), use the Macro mode (left column).
- When the camera cannot focus on the subject automatically, the AE/AF lock indicator changes to flashing slowly and the beep does not sound. Recompose the shot and focus again.

Subjects difficult to focus on are:

- -Distant from the camera and dark
 - -Reflect light or have a lustrous finish

-Against light


- -The contrast between the subject and its background is poor.
- -Seen through glass
- -Moving fast

To turn off the LCD screen

Press | | (Display/LCD on/off) repeatedly. Use the finder for saving battery power, or shooting images when it is difficult to confirm images using the LCD screen.

To use the functions set by the control button with Scene Selection

Before shooting in step **6**, select the settings with the control button. Some functions are not available, depending on the Scene Selection mode. When you press the button to select functions that cannot be combined with Scene Selection, a beep sounds. → "User's Guide/ Troubleshooting" (page 27)

To view an enlarged image (playback zoom)

While displaying a still image, press

to zoom in on the image.

To undo the zoom, press Q

Adjust the portion: **△**/**▼**/**◄**/**▶**

Cancel playback zoom:

Viewing an index screen

Press \blacksquare (index), then select an image with $\triangle/\nabla/\blacktriangleleft/\triangleright$.

To return to the single-image screen, press ●. To display the next (previous) index screen, press











To delete images in index mode

- 1 While an index screen is displayed, press # / m (Delete) and select [Select] with ▲/▼ on the control button, then press

 .
- 2 Select the image you want to delete with △/▼/◄/▶, then press to display the (Delete) indicator on the selected image.





Select an image you have previously selected for deletion, then press lacktriangle to delete the $\overline{\parallel}$ indicator from the image.

3 Press # / m (Delete).

4 Select [OK] with ▶, then press ●.

• To delete all the images in the folder, select [All In This Folder] with **△/▼** in step 1 instead of [Select], then

^{*}The shutter speed becomes slower, so using a tripod is recommended.
