操作

コンピューターのコントロールソフトウェアは、カメラの電源を入れて映像が出た後に立ち上げてください。

使用・保存場所

非常に明るい被写体（照明や太陽など）を長時間にわたって撮影しないでください。また、次のような場所での使用や保管は避けてください。

- 極端に暑い所や寒い場所（動作温度：－5℃～＋60℃）
- 強力な電波を発するテレビやラジオの送信所の近く
- 蛍光灯や窓の反射の影響を受ける所
- 不安定な照明の下（フリッカーを起こします。）
- 激しく振動する所
- レーザー光を映さない

お手入れ

レンズ表面に付着したごみやほこりは、市販のプロアーで払ってください。

その他

- 本機の仕様および外観は、改良のため予告なく変更することがありますが、ご了承ください。
- 規定外の電源電圧は加えないでください。規定外の電源電圧での使用は、火災や感電の原因になります。
- 本カメラに搭載されている CMOS 撮像素子および IC は、静電気が印加されると破壊に至る場合があります。直接ハンドリングする場合はアースバンドを使用し、作業台などの下には導電マットなどを敷き、静電気防止対策をしてください。

- 異常や不具合が起きたときは、お買い上げ店にご相談ください。

本機の取り扱いについて

- 本機取扱いの際は、板金カバー以外の全ての部分に過度な負荷をかけないように注意してください。故障の原因となります。
- 本機は、ハウジングへの組込みを前提としているため、太陽光のような強い光を直接前面以外の方向から受けないようにしてください。画像品質劣化の原因となります。

CMOS 特有の現象

撮影画面に出る下記の現象は、CMOS 撮像素子特有の現象で、故障ではありません。

ローリングシャッター

CMOS は方式上、各ラインごとにシャッターを切っていますので、画面上と下では時間差が発生するため、カメラを動かすと縦の映像が斜めになります。

白点

CMOS 撮像素子は非常に精密な技術で作られていますが、宇宙線などの影響により、まれに画面上に微小な白点が発生する場合があります。

これは CMOS 撮像素子の原理に起因するもので故障ではありません。

また、下記の場合、白点が見えやすくなります。

- 高温の環境で使用するとき
- マスターゲイン（感度）を上げたとき
- スローシャッターモードのとき

折り返しひずみ

細かい模様、線などを撮影すると、ぎざぎざやちらつきが見えることがあります。

レンズ特有の現象

ゴースト

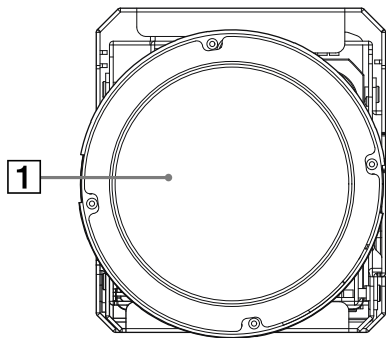
太陽など強い光がレンズ入射角の近くにあった場合、レンズ内側での乱反射から映像に高輝度の影が現れることがあります。

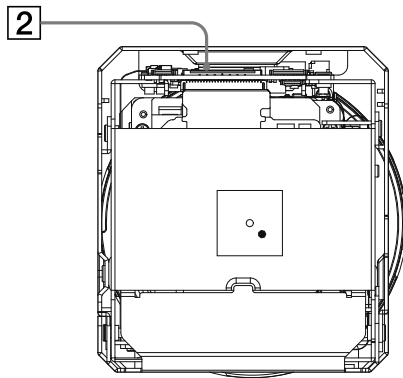

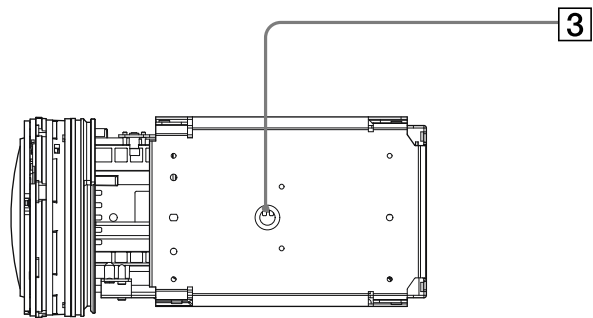

三脚を使うときは、ネジの長さが 6 mm 以下のものをお使いください。

また、必ず三脚固定用ネジでしっかり固定してください。

基本機能

機能説明

カメラコントロールは、VISCA コマンド及び、PTP を用いたコマンドで行います。PTP によるカメラコントロールは別冊の「カメラコントロール PTP 編」をご覧ください。

一般

- **Power On/Off**
カメラの電源を On/Off します。
Off 時は画面は非表示ですが、VISCA コマンドを受け付けます。
- **I/F Clear**
FCB カメラ内のコマンドバッファをクリアします。
- **Address Set**
VISCA はデジチェーンが可能なプロトコルで、RS-232C のラインに 7 台のカメラを接続できます。この時アドレスセットによって 1 ～ 7 番までのアドレスを割り振れば、同一 PC でカメラをコントロールすることができます。
FCB シリーズはカメラを直接チェーン接続することはできませんが、新しくカメラを接続した場合は必ずアドレスセットによってアドレスを確定してください。
- **ID Write**
カメラに ID を設定します。
- **Mute**
画面を消して同期信号を出します。
- **Lens Initialize**
レンズのズームとフォーカスのイニシャライズを行います。電源 On 時にもズームとフォーカスのイニシャライズを実施します。
- **APR (Auto Pixel Restoration)**
FCB カメラの動作中にセットの温度が上がり、CMOS 撮像素子の白点が発生する場合があります。
APR は、この白点を検出補正し、目立たなくします。

APR の検出機能は白点が発生している状態で行う必要があります。

通電直後などでカメラの温度が上がらず、白点が発生していない状態で APR を用いても検出することができませんので、必ず白点が発生している状態で使用してください。

APR を ON にし、電源 OFF/ON を行うことで、白点が検出補正されセットに記録されます。

APR による補正が終了しましたら、必ず“APR”を OFF にしてください。補正のデータは“APR”が OFF でも維持されます。

ズーム

12 倍光学ズームレンズを採用しています。デジタルズームを使用すると 144 倍までズームできます。

- **光学 12 倍、 $f=9.3\text{ mm} \sim 111.6\text{ mm}$ (F2.8 ～ F4.5)**

ズームには次のモードがあります。

スタンダードモード

バリエابلモード

ズームスピードは 8 ステップあります。

- ◆ スタンダード、バリエابلモードではこのコマンド自体ではストップしません。
ストップさせる場合は、ストップコマンドを送る必要があります。

ダイレクトモード

ズームポジションを設定することにより、指定の位置に最速で移動します。

デジタルズーム

デジタルズームモードには、OFF、コンバインモード、セパレートモードがあります。

コンバインモード

従来のズーム方式です。光学ズームが MAX になった後にデジタルズームモードになります。

セパレートモード

光学ズームとデジタルズームを独自に操作できるモードです。

光学倍率のどこからでもデジタルズームの倍率を操作できます。

コンバインモードの場合はデジタルズームの範囲を設定できます。

スーパーレゾリューションズーム

ソニー独自開発の「全画素超解像技術」により、拡大時でも画質を低下させることなく解像感を保ったまま優れた画像を提供します。

光学ズーム 12 倍との組み合わせにより、QFHD では 18 倍、FHD では 24 倍までズームを実現します。

Continuous Zoom Position Reply について

コマンドで Continues Zoom Position Reply を On にすると、ズームダイレクトモード時やプリセット動作時でのズーム移動時に、随時ズームポジションのデータをカメラから出力します。

フォーカス

フォーカスには次のモードがあります。

• Auto Focus Mode

AF（オートフォーカス）は、画面中心の測定枠内で映像信号レベルの高い周波数成分、つまり輝度が高くコントラストの強いものにフォーカスを合わせます。最短合焦距離は wide 端で 80 mm、tele 端で 1000 mm です。

- Normal AF Mode

通常の AF が常に働いているモードです。

- Interval AF Mode

AF 動作をある一定間隔で実施するモードです。AF の動作時間とストップしている時間は Set Time コマンドにより 1 秒単位で設定が可能です。初期値はそれぞれ 5 秒に設定されています。

- Zoom Trigger Mode

ズームを動かしたとき、設定した時間だけ（初期値は 5 秒）AF モードとなり、その後止まります。

• AF Sensitivity

AF の感度切り換えの設定が可能です。

- Normal

フォーカスの追従速度が速くなります。動きの多い被写体を撮影する際ご利用ください。通常はこのモードが最適です。

- Low

フォーカスの安定性が向上します。照度が低いとき、明るさが多少変化しても AF は動作せず、安定した画像が得られます。

• Manual Focus Mode

マニュアルフォーカスにはスタンダードモード、バリアブルモードがあります。スタンダードモードは固定のスピードで移動します。バリアブルモードは 8 ステップのスピードがあります。

◆ スタンダード、バリアブルモードではこのコマンド自体ではストップしません。ストップさせる場合は、ストップコマンドを送る必要があります。

• One Push Trigger Mode

Trigger コマンドを送ったとき、被写体にフォーカスが合うようにレンズが移動します。次の Trigger コマンドが入るまでフォーカスレンズはそのままの位置を保ちます。

• Near Limit 設定

1000 (∞) ~ F000 (80 mm) まで設定が可能です。
初期値 : B000h (25 cm)

• スポットフォーカスモード

特定の部分にフォーカスを合わせることができます。

通常のオートフォーカスで目的の被写体にピントが合いにくいときなどに用います。

フォーカスを合わせる範囲は、画面全体を縦 16 × 横 16 に分割した領域で指定します。

ホワイトバランス

ホワイトバランスには以下のモードがあります。

• Auto

画面全体の色情報からホワイトバランスの出力を計算するモードです。カメラ内部に設定した黒体放射上の色温度カーブ (2500K ~ 7500K) に適合した出力値が出ます。初期値はこのモードに設定されています。

• ATW

Auto Tracing White balance (2000K ~ 10000K)

• Indoor

3200K 基準モード

• Outdoor

5800K 基準モード

• One Push WB

ワンプッシュホワイトバランスは、一度被写体を照らす照明条件を設定すると強制的に白に引き込み、その条件のまま撮影できる機能です。被写体の周りの条件に影響されないでそのままの色を自然に出します。設定する場合、白に引き込みたい被写体を写してワンプッシュホワイトバランストリガーを送ります。

ワンプッシュホワイトバランスのデータは電源を Off にすると消去されます。電源を一度 Off にした場合は、再度ワンプッシュホワイトバランスを設定してください。

• Manual WB

R ゲインと B ゲインを手動で 256 ステップまで設定できるモードです。

• Outdoor Auto

屋外専用のオートホワイトバランスモードです。朝方、夕方のホワイトバランスが自然になります。

• Sodium Vapor Lamp Auto

Sodium Vapor Lamp (ナトリウムランプ) に対応したオートホワイトバランスモードです。

- **Sodium Vapor Lamp**
Sodium Vapor Lamp（ナトリウムランプ）専用の固定ホワイトバランスモードです。
- **Sodium Vapor Lamp Outdoor Auto**
Sodium Vapor Lamp（ナトリウムランプ）に対応した屋外専用のオートホワイトバランスモードです。

ご注意

ナトリウムランプは、高圧ナトリウムに対応しています。低圧では一部引き込まないものがあります。

AE（自動露光モード）

高輝度から低照度の被写体まで最適に映し出せるように、多彩な露光調整ができます。

- **Full Auto**
アイリス、ゲイン、シャッタースピードを自動で調整します。
- **Gain Limit 設定**
AE モード Full Auto、シャッター優先、アイリス優先、ブライト、スポット露光および Manual モードでゲインリミットの設定が可能です。S/N を重視した映像を得たい場合は、この設定を利用してください。
- **シャッター優先¹⁾**
アイリスとゲインは Auto、シャッタースピードは任意の設定（1/1 ～ 1/10,000 秒、高速 16 ステップ+低速 12 ステップ）で調整します。
1) 東日本地域（電源周波数 50 Hz）でのフリッカーは、1/100 秒に設定することによりなくなります。
- **アイリス優先**
ゲインとシャッタースピードは Auto、アイリスは任意の設定（F2.8 ～ F11、17 ステップ）で調整します。
- **ゲイン**
アイリスとシャッタースピードは、ゲインは任意の設定（0 ～ 36 dB、13 ステップ、高感度モード時 0 ～ 48 dB、17 ステップ）で調整します。
- **Manual**
シャッタースピード、アイリス、ゲインの任意の設定で調整します。
- **ブライト**
アイリスとゲインの組み合わせ（F11 ～ F2.8 までは 29 ステップ、高感度モードで 33 ステップ）で調整します。

AE－シャッター優先

高速 16 ステップ、低速 12 ステップ、計 28 ステップの設定が可能です。スローシャッターの設定を行うと、被写体の明るさに応じてスローシャッターとなります。ただしメモリーを通しての出力ですので、AF の追従性は低下し、表示されるフレーム数も低下します。高速シャッターは 1/10,000 秒まで設定が可能です。アイリスとゲインは自動となります。

ゲインとシャッタースピードは自動となります。

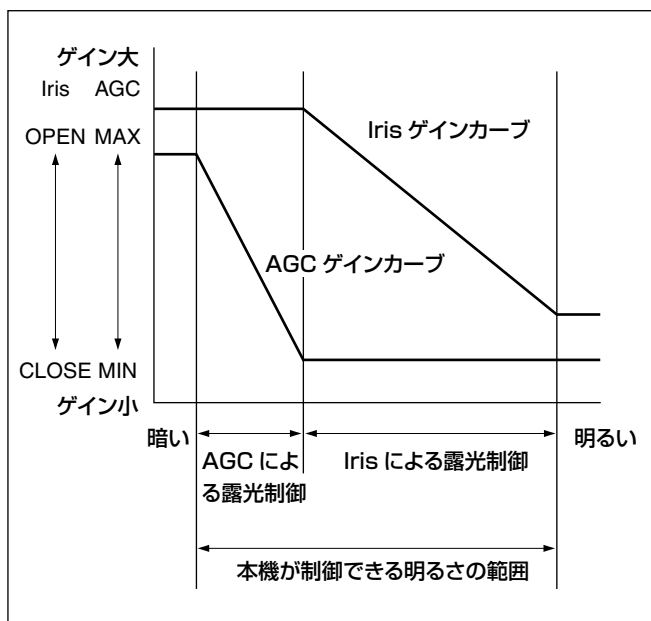
シャッタースピード (28 ステップ)、アイリス (17 ステップ)、ゲイン (17 ステップ) を個々に設定が可能です。

AE ブライト

ブライトコントロールはゲインおよびアイリスの組み合わせによる明るさ調整機能です。暗い場合はゲインによる露光制御、明るい場合はアイリスによる露光制御が行われます。

ゲイン、アイリスともに固定となりますので、カメラの感度を一定にして撮影するときを使用します。Full Auto またはシャッター優先モードからブライトモードに切り換えた場合、いったん切り換え前の状態をホールドします。

AE モードが、Full Auto モードまたはシャッター優先モードの場合にだけブライトモードに切り換えることができます。

シャッター優先モードからブライトモードへ切り換えた場合は、シャッター優先モード時に設定したシャッタースピードが保持されます。

Gain Limit 設定

AE モードの Full Auto、シャッター優先、アイリス優先でゲインリミットの設定が可能です。S/N を重視した映像を得たい場合は、この設定を利用してください。

Gain Point 設定

0dB とゲインリミットの中間に設定して、設定値のゲインに達した時点からシャッタースピードを変更することが可能です。

動体を優先した映像を得たい場合は、この設定を利用してください。

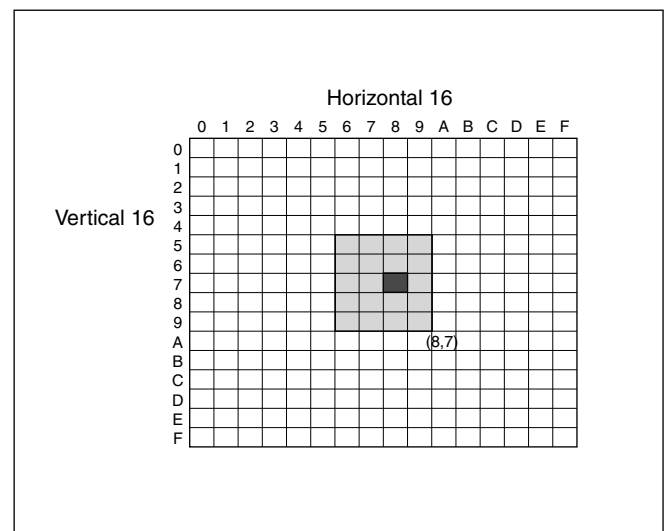
スポット露光モード

Full Auto AE では画面全体のレベルを算出し、それが最適になるように絞り、ゲインなどを決定しています。スポット AE では被写体の特定の部分を指定することで、その部分に重み付けをして計算し、ゲイン、アイリスなどが最適に働いて画像を得ることができます。

例えば、動きが多く、輝度変化が激しいような画面では、変化の少ないところにスポットを指定することで画面の変化を抑えることができます。

下図のように縦 16 横 16 の範囲で指定できます。

指定した中心（黒）を含む周辺ブロック（アミ）の値でレベルを算出します。スポット AE 枠は、縦 5 横 4 に固定されています。



露出補正

露出補正は AE 時の明るさを調整する機能です。標準の明るさを「0」とし、これに対し 1.5 dB ずつワンステップで明るくしたり暗くしたりできます。

スロー AE（自動露光モード）

スロー AE Response（自動露光応答）機能は、露光の応答スピードを遅くする機能です。通常は、約 1 秒で適切な露光になるように、自動的に収束するよう設定されています。露光の応答スピードは、スロー AE 機能を使って、初期設定値（01h）～約 10 分（30h）（通常シャッター時）まで遅くすることができます。

例えば、通常の設定（約 1 秒）では、車のヘッドライトが画面に入ると、すぐに高輝度（ヘッドライト）を映し出せるように露光を調節します。従って、周辺の画面つまり、車のヘッドライト以外の被写体は相対的に暗くなり、識別ができなくなります。

しかし、スロー AE 機能を使えば応答時間が長くなり、高輝度（ヘッドライト）光が短時間映った場合でも、周辺被写体はきちんと識別できるようになります。

高解像度モード

エッジを強調し、より解像度感のある映像が得られます。

輪郭強調（アパーチャー）

被写体の輪郭を強調する機能です。Auto の場合には自動的に調整します。

Manual に設定することで複数の設定項目を調整することができますようになります。ゲインアップした際に発生するノイズ粒子にも輪郭強調によって輪郭がつき、目立つノイズになることがあります。レベルの調整で輪郭強調の強度を抑えるか、クリスプニングでノイズにつく輪郭強調の量を調整してください。

逆光補正

被写体の背景が明るすぎ、AE によって被写体が暗くなったときに逆光補正を行うと被写体が見やすくなります。

Visibility Enhancer (VE)

撮像シーンに応じてカメラ画像の暗い部分を明るくし、はっきり見えるように輝度とコントラストを自動補正します。

Defog モード

被写体に霧がかかり、コントラストが低くなったときに Defog モードにすると被写体が見やすくなります。

この機能は OFF、弱、中、強の 4 段階が選択できます。

Highlight Compensation (HLC)

HLC（ハイライト補正）は、強力なスポット光を検出して AE や AF を調整し、必要に応じて光エリアをマスクします。屋内駐車場や夜間の屋外で自動車の数やナンバープレートを読み取りやすくします。

Maximum Shutter Limit（高速シャッターリミット）

被写体が明るくなるとシャッター速度が速くなりますが、そのシャッター速度の上限にリミットをかける機能です。明るい被写体を撮像する際にパラパラ感が抑制されて滑らかな動きの映像になります。

Minimum Shutter Limit（低速シャッターリミット）

被写体が暗くなるとシャッター速度が遅くなってからゲインを上げますが、このシャッター速度にリミットをかける機能です。暗所で移動する物体を撮像する際にぶれを抑えます。

ノイズリダクション

NR（Noise Reduction）は、ノイズ（固定パターンノイズ、ランダムノイズなど）を除去して、より鮮明な映像を得るための機能です。

この機能は、Off の状態を含めて、レベル 1 からレベル 5 まで 6 段階あります。

効果はゲインに応じて段階的にかかり、設定値は NR 効果のリミッターとなります。なお、明るい条件では、レベルを変更しても NR の効果はありません。

レベル 7Fh に設定したときは、2D/3D の NR を個別に設定ができます。

高感度モード

最大ゲイン量が増加し、より暗い環境でも明るい出力が得られます。

ただし、ゲインが強くなっている状態ではノイズの多い映像となります。

ガンマ可変モード

スタンダード (00h)、ストレートガンマ (01h)、512 パターン (02h) の設定が可能です。

ガンマオフセット

ガンマ可変の各モードで、-64 (140h) ~ +64 (040h) で輝度の設定が可能です。

温度読み出し機能

カメラ内部に付いている温度センサーの換算値 (hex) を問い合わせコマンドで読み出すことができます。換算値には±3℃の誤差があり、かつ温度センサーはカメラ内部に付いているため、この換算値はカメラの周囲温度ではありません。参考値としてお使いください。

スローシャッター On/Off

「On」に設定すると、被写体照度が下がったときに自動でスローシャッターに入るように制御します。AE モードが Full Auto のときのみ有効です。初期値は「オートスローシャッター Off」に設定されています。

低照度色消しモード

低照度での色消しの設定が可能です。低照度での色ノイズが気になる場合に有効です。

低照度色消しの設定は、4 段階の設定（無効と 3 段階の有効）が可能です。

ICR (IR カットリムーバブル) モード

CMOS の前に装着されている IR カットフィルターをメカニカルな機構で装着したり、取りはずしたりすることができます。IR カットフィルターを取りはずすことで、赤外領域の感度がアップし、より暗いところの映像をとらえることができます。

なお、ICR モードを On にした場合は、「白黒」の映像となります。

カラーゲイン可変

カラーゲインの設定が可能です。鮮やかな色を希望する場合に有効です。

カラーゲインの初期値設定 100% (4h) を、約 60% (0h) ~ 約 200% (Eh) まで 15 段階の設定が可能です。

カラー位相可変

カラー位相の設定が可能です。

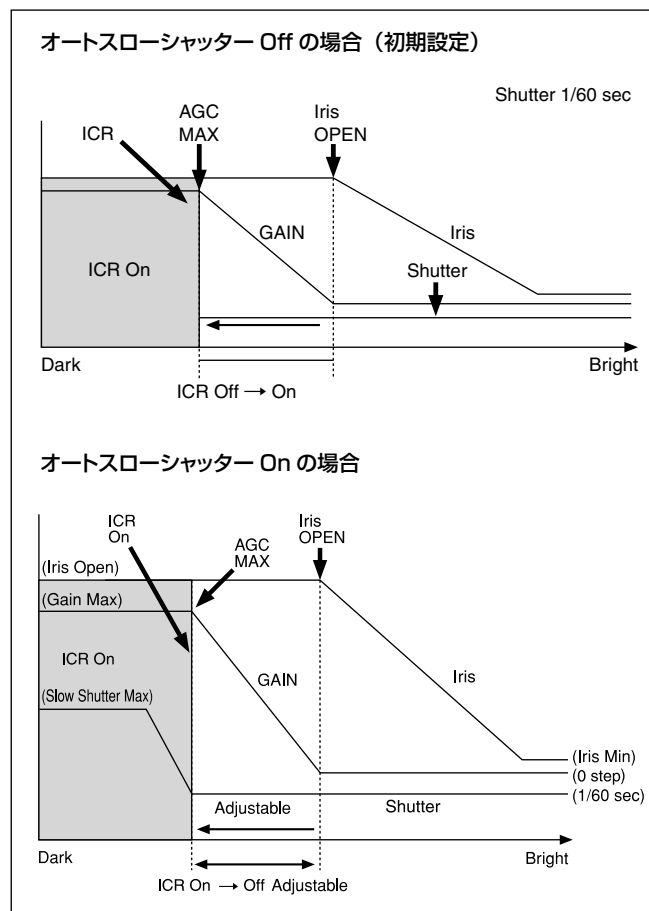
カラー位相の初期値は 0 度 (7h) で、約 -14 度 (0h) から約 +14 度 (Eh) まで 15 段階の設定が可能です。

Auto ICR モード

オート ICR モードは IR カットフィルターの脱着を自動で行います。ある一定の暗さになると自動的に IR カットフィルターを取り除き (ICR On)、赤外領域の感度をアップさせる機能です。また、ある一定の明るさになると自動的に IR カットフィルターを装着します (ICR Off)。

なお、IR ライト装着のシステムにおいても、誤動作が起きないようにカメラの内部データを活用して判断しています。

オート ICR モードは、AE Full Auto 設定で機能します。



で注意

On/Off の条件には明るさ以外の情報も利用しているため、画面いっぱい青っぽい被写体を映した場合などに誤動作する場合があります。

ND フィルターモード

CMOS センサーの前に装着されている ND フィルターをメカニカルな機構で装着したり、取りはずしたりすることができます。

ND フィルターを使用することでアイリス、およびシャッタースピードの調整幅を増やすことができます。

ND フィルターは 2 種類あり、組み合わせにより、光量を 1 倍（フィルター Off）、1/4 倍、1/16 倍、1/64 倍にできます。

カメラ ID

65,536 (0000h ~ FFFFh) 台までの ID 設定が可能です。内部の不揮発性メモリーへ記憶されるので、データは保存されます。

Picture Effect

以下の機能があります。

- **Black & White:** 白黒映像

イメージスタビライザー

イメージスタビライザー機能を On にすると、振動などで起こる画面ぶれに対して、ぶれの少ない映像を得られます。

10 Hz 前後の振動周波数で補正効果があります。イメージスタビライザー機能は、光学振れ補正方式を採用しており、画角の変化はごく僅かで、解像度と感度は保持されます。

ご注意

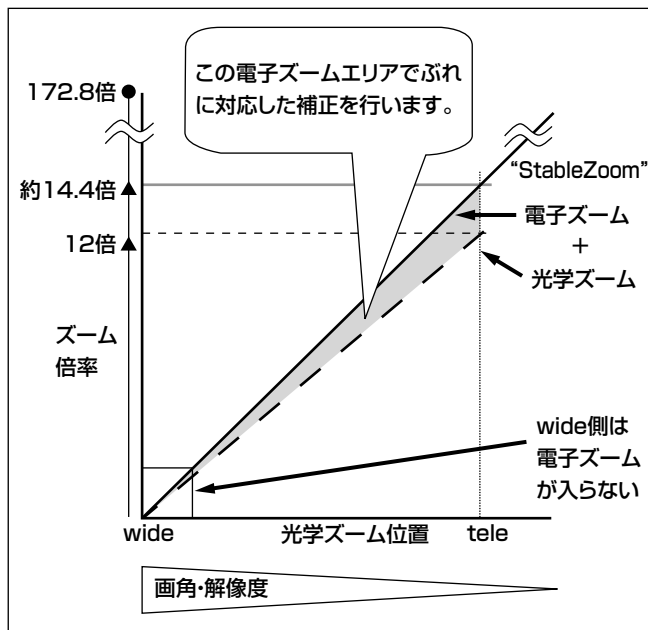
高周波の振動成分がある環境下では、手ブレ補正が正しく働かない場合があります。そのような環境下で使用する場合には、イメージスタビライザー機能 Off にしてご使用ください。

“StableZoom”

“StableZoom” は、ズーム倍率に応じてイメージスタビライザー機能による補正を行い、光学ズームと電子ズームを合わせて、なめらかに約 24 倍までズームする機能です。さらに電子ズームすると、最大 288 倍になります。

wide 側では、電子ズームが入らないため、解像度が低下しない映像が得られます。一方、tele 側では、イメージスタビライザー機能による補正効果が最大になり、ぶれを抑えます。

“StableZoom” は、レジスター設定で On/Off できます。



その他

上下左右反転

この機能によりカメラからの映像出力を上下左右反転できます。

左右反転

この機能によりカメラからの映像出力を左右反転できます。

フリーズ

VISCA ではコンピューターなどコマンドを出す側をコントローラー、FCB カメラなどコマンドを受ける側を周辺機器と呼びます。FCB カメラはそれが一つの周辺機器となります。VISCA では RS-232C に準拠した通信を用い、FCB カメラのような周辺機器を 1 台のコントローラーに 7 台まで接続することができます。RS-232C のパラメーターは以下のとおりです。

- 通信速度：9.6 kbps/19.2 kbps/38.4 kbps/115.2 kbps
- データ長：8 ビット
- スタートビット：1 ビット
- ストップビット：1 ビット
- パリティなし

XON/XOff、RTS/CTS などを使用するフローコントロールはサポートしていません。

VISCA の通信形式

VISCA パケットの構造

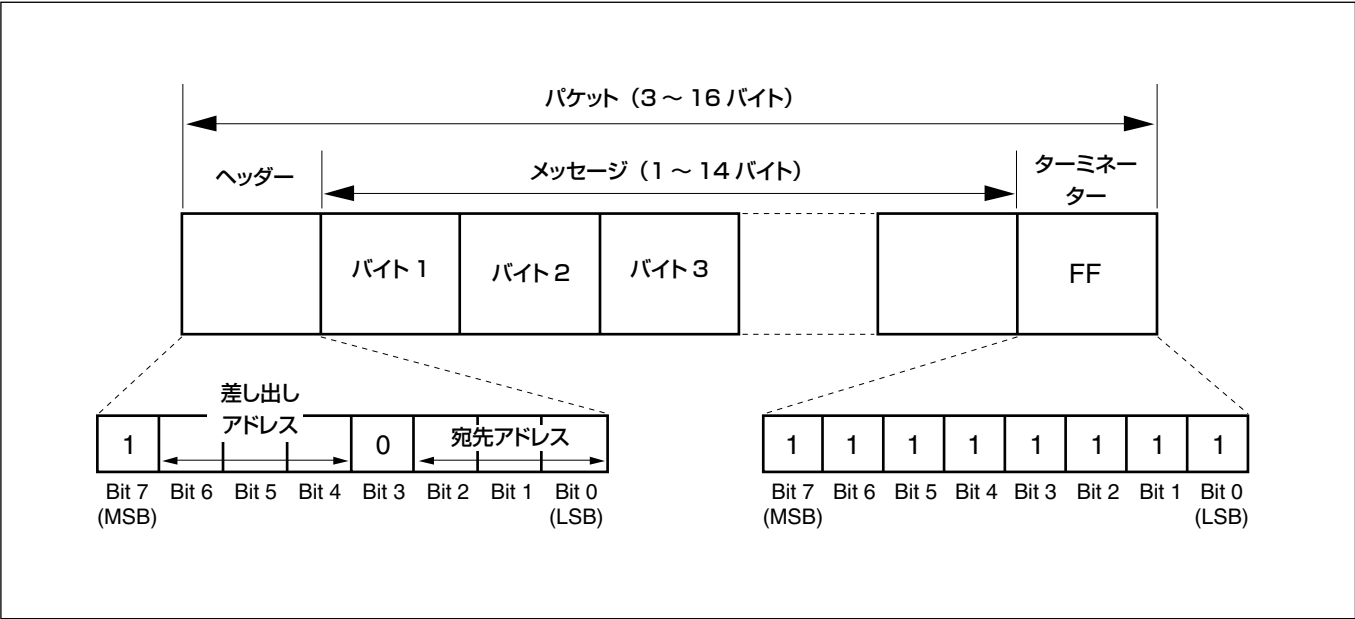
VISCA 通信の基本単位をパケットと呼びます。パケットの最初のバイトはヘッダーと呼び、差し出しと宛先のアドレスが入っています。例えば、アドレス 0 のコントローラからアドレス 1 の FCB カメラへ送るパケットのヘッダーは 16 進数で 81h となります。アドレス 2 の FCB カメラへ送るパケットは 82h となります。コマンドリスト表ではヘッダーを 8X としてありますので、X の部分に FCB カメラのアドレスを入れてください。また、アドレス 1 の FCB カメラからの応答パケットのヘッダーは 90h となります。アドレス 2 の FCB カメラからのパケットは A0h となります。

カメラ ID に依らずコマンドを送信することをブロードキャストといいます。

ブロードキャストの場合はヘッダーを 16 進数で 88h とします。

ターミネーターは FFh でパケットの終わりを示します。

ブロードキャストで送信されたコマンドに対し、カメラ側で対応できるのは Address Set と IF_Clear の2つのコマンドのみです。

FCB カメラにコマンドメッセージを送ったときは、完了メッセージかエラーメッセージが戻ってくるのを待ってから次のコマンドメッセージを送るようにしてください。しかし、より高度な使い方に対応するため、FCB カメラはコマンド用のバッファ（メモリ）を 2 組持っていて、実行中のコマンドを含めて 2 つまでのコマンドを受け取れるようになっています。FCB カメラはコマンドを受け取ったとき、どちらのコマンドバッファを使ったかを Acknowledge メッセージのソケット番号で知らせます。完了メッセージやエラーメッセージにもソケット番号がついているので、どちら

のコマンドが終了したのかを知ることができます。コマンドバッファが 2 つとも使われているときでも、FCB カメラ管理用コマンドと一部の問い合わせメッセージは実行可能です。

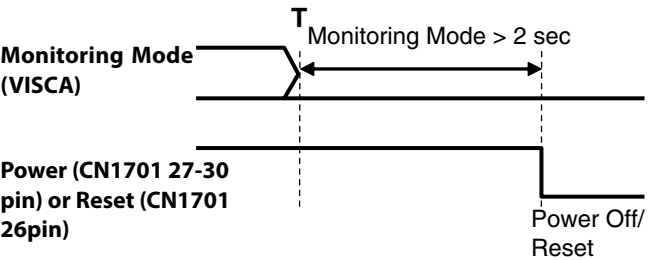

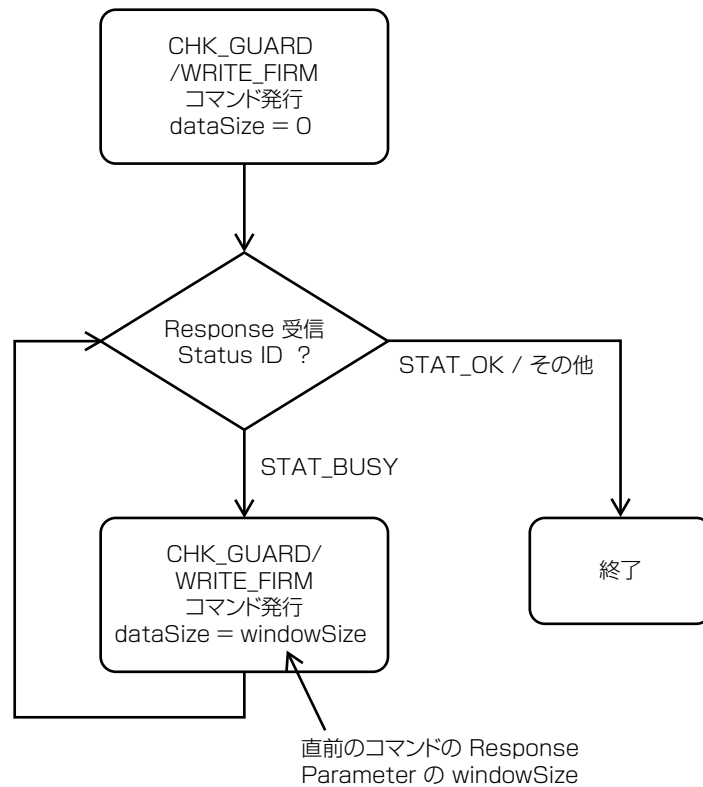

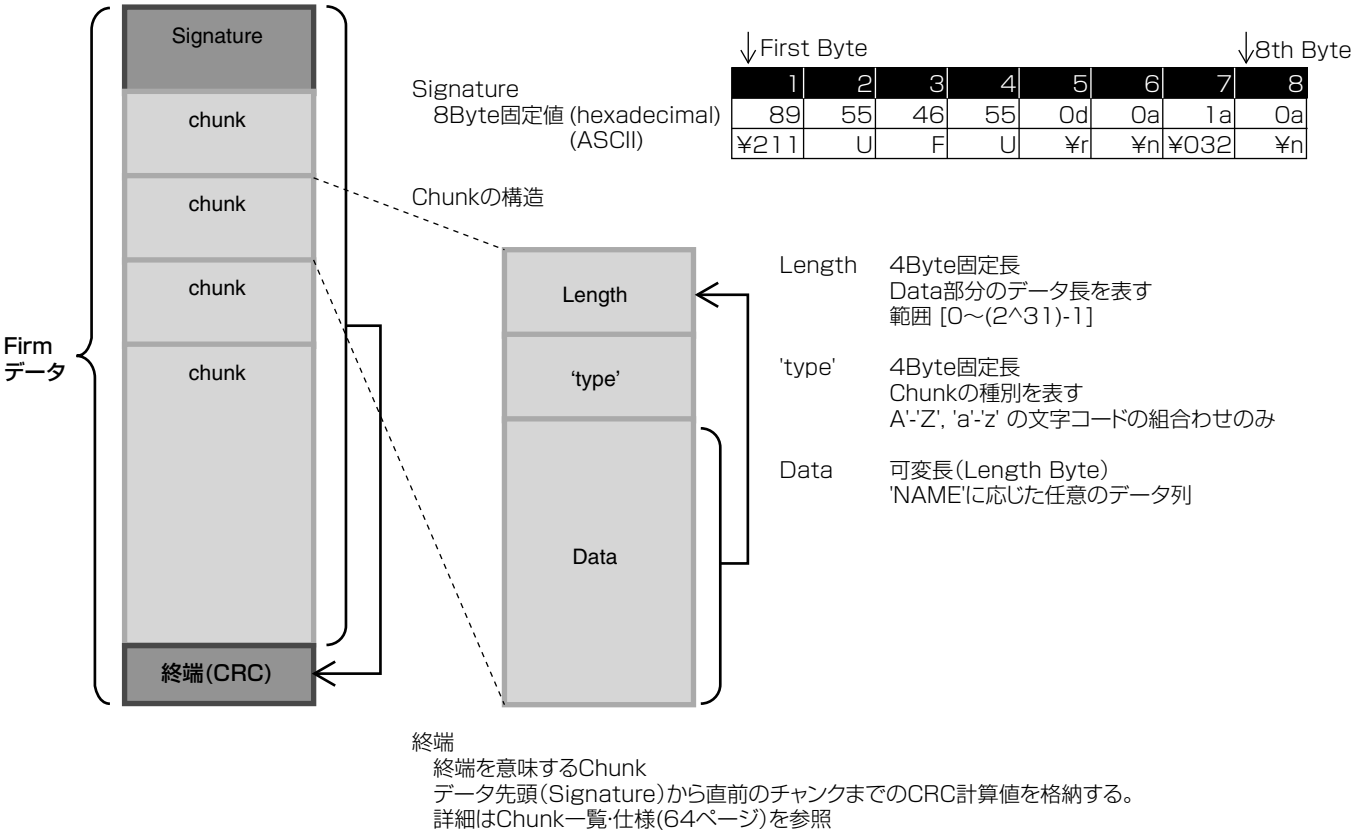


カメラ Mode / Updater Mode の判別方法

UUD Firmware データ構造に記載されているように、ファームウェアパッケージのデータの UDID Chunk に Update の対象となる機器の USB PID、USB VID、動作モードが記載されています。アップデートするホストは、本機から USB Descriptor を取得した USB PID、USB VID が UDID Chunk に含まれることを確認し、その ID の動作モードによって、本機がカメラ Mode で起動しているか、Updater Mode で起動しているかを判断してください。
